Preserving Diverse Cultures Division

Strategies for Success is a participatory, multi-year, multi-level capacity-building program that addresses and supports organizational development with an emphasis on entities serving historically under-represented diverse communities including those whose members identify as BIPOC. Support is provided through implementation awards, technical assistance, and professional development workshops and conferences. Participation in the program is based on three levels of organizational readiness - Basic, Intermediate, and Advanced.

Potential panelists should have knowledge of and experience in the management of arts organizations and/or programs, and community engagement as artists or administrators; and, who represent the diversity of our applicants.

Folk & Traditional Arts Program

The **Apprenticeships in Traditional Arts** (ATA) grant program supports the learning of folk and traditional arts within cultural communities and funds partnerships between master traditional artists and qualified apprentices.

Potential panelists should have knowledge of and experience in folk and traditional arts as artists, administrators, and/or educators.

Panelists

Panelists thoroughly review and independently score submitted applications and will be assigned several of those applications to present during the virtual panel meeting. Panelists collectively make recommendations for funding for all applications during the panel meeting. Panelist recommendations guide the Council in the use and distribution of public funds.

Panelists must participate in one of the hour-long scheduled orientation sessions prior to receipt of assigned application materials.
